## Feedback Summary

### School Development Plan

- All participants surveyed reported that they learn about the School Development Plan (SDP) through School Council Meetings.
- All participants agreed that their child's learning can benefit from the goals, outcomes, actions, and resources outlined in the SDP.
- When asked whether the learning needs of all students are reflected and prioritized in the goals, outcomes, actions, and resources in the SDP, all participants agreed in the affirmative. Parents also mentioned that this question is difficult to answer because they are not aware of the full range of student needs within the school.

### School Budget and Fees

- When asked which activities and services are most important, all participants agreed that field trips, guest speakers, technology, residencies, and opportunities for athletics are valuable. Council members re-affirmed that they work hard to raise funds for field trips, residencies, and in school programming.
- Council members commented that residencies that build skills and that expose students to cultural learning have a positive effect on helping students to feel connected to their school.
- All participants agreed that the activities provided by the school are important for their child's learning. Participants also reported that school fees are reasonable considering the benefits to their child.
