

The classroom teacher is at the centre of your child's learning team and is supported by a school learning team. Based on classroom needs, each kindergarten program will also be supported by a multidisciplinary team that works with large and small groups in the classroom.

This team may consist of:

Education Assistants or Early Childhood Practitioners
Early Learning Strategists
Speech-Language Pathologists (SLPs)
Psychologists
Occupational Therapists (OTs)
Physiotherapists (PTs)
School Family Liaison (SFL)

68% of our students speak a language at home other than English

We have staff members who speak Punjabi, Hindi, Urdu, Pashtu, Arabic, Kurdish, French

Getting Ready for Kindergarten





Build your child's independence by encouraging them to:





- dress themselves (zippers, buttons, shoes & boots!)
- use the bathroom and wash their hands on their own
- put away toys and help out in other small ways at home
- practice opening and closing snack containers and using a water bottle
- play games, take turns and compromise
- develop a consistent bedtime routine



Getting Ready for Kindergarten





Read to your child every day:



- •read stories together in *your first language* to help your child develop vocabulary, listening and speaking skills
- •enjoy reading different types of books: picture books, information books, nursery rhymes, poetry



- •encourage your child to talk about the pictures and stories as you read together
- visit your community library (when possible)

Getting Ready for Kindergarten





Take time to talk with your child about everyday activities:






- share special activities together, such as walks to the park
- talk about what you are seeing and doing
- talk, read, sing and play in *your first language* every day
- praise children for their efforts and courage to overcome setbacks

One-way bussing for Kindergarten

- Morning Program Bus to school, parents pick up
- Afternoon Program Parents drop off, children ride the bus home

Kindergarten students are walked to their bus by an adult

- Share your clearance document with the school

Security Clearance is valid for 5 years. A new school volunteer form will need to be filled out each year
